PRICING

A. Official Delegation

- a. FOR ONE TEAM - An official team delegation consists of a maximum of seven people which include: 3 teen entrepreneurs, 1 coach, 1 accredited judge, 1 publicist and 1 national coordinator, maximum 4 rooms
- b. FOR TWO TEAMS - An official team delegation consists of a maximum of twelve people which include of 6 teen entrepreneurs, 2 coaches, 2 accredited judges, 1 publicist and 1 national coordinator, maximum 6 rooms

B. Continental Coordinators

- a. Continental Coordinators with a signed MOU on file with the SAGE Global will be given one single room and the conference package paid for by SAGE Global

C. Observing Countries

- a. By invitation only – One delegate from a country with no SAGE program yet but are observing will be given a double room and the conference package paid for by SAGE Global, observing delegates may share a room with another person of the same age/gender

D. Supplemental Delegates – Participants fund their own attendance, fees for the conference package are:

- a. One Room single occupancy \$1200 USD
- b. One Room double occupancy \$1000 USD per person
- c. One Room triple occupancy \$1000 USD per person
- d. Fees are due before 30 Jun 2019
- e. There will be no proration of fees for any reason

- SAGE Global reserves the right to audit and determine an accredited judge's ability to read, write, and speak the English language and may remove a judge from competition for inability to communicate in the English language

- Submissions for the Sustainable Development Goal Competition were due 15 July 2019
- Prizes are \$100 USD for the Gold Medal Winner for each Sustainable Development Goal

WELCOME RECEPTION AND LEAGUE DRAWING

- Overnight guests will attend the welcome reception and league drawings.
- Teams will be randomly selected and then given the option to select their presentation time slot
- If a team's name is drawn and the team is not present a representative from SAGE Global will select your time slot for you
- It is your business' responsibility to know the date, time, and location of your presentation

CULTURAL OUTING

- Bus transportation will be provided, you are responsible to be at the bus/pier meeting points at the designated times, if you miss the bus/boat you will need to make your own transportation arrangements and/or forego the cultural outing/activity

CULTURAL NIGHT

- One presentation per country - This means your whole country, (both teams), can do one presentation together
- Presentation length is 5 minutes maximum showcasing your country and its culture
- Bring your cultural presentation media on a flash drive to be uploaded on 8 August during the Welcome Reception to the SAGE Creative Director, Paul Perez
- Observing countries will not be able present on cultural night, observing countries may have time to speak briefly at the Gala Dinner.
- The SAGE Creative Director is authorized to cancel any song or dance performance that is deemed unsuitable for VIP government guests or attendees of young age.

TRADE EXPO

- Each country will be given a table for display
- Table displays - in previous years countries have:
 - displayed and sold their business products
 - offered complimentary samples of traditional food and/or drink
 - given out travel brochures or postcards of their country or hometown
 - given complimentary souvenirs or tokens

- given demonstrations – like braiding hair in a country’s traditional style or writing a name in foreign script/alphabet
