• SAGE entrepreneurs compete regionally and nationally, with the top two teams from each country being invited to compete at the annual SAGE World Cup, hosted in a different country each year.

• An accredited panel of judges score live presentations that include the review of annual reports, a multi-media presentation and dedicated time for Q&A.

• Judging criteria is comprised of: 1) business operations; 2) social impact: 3) creativity and innovation: 4) likelihood the business will continue; and 5) overall **presentation**. The winning team receives prize money and an acclaimed trophy identifying them and their country as the best teenage entrepreneurs of the year!
